A Report from the 21st Century Commission on the Future of Community Colleges



The Commission believes that community colleges must change their institutional characteristics as follows:

From a focus on **student access** to a focus on access and **student success**.

From low rates of student success to high rates of student success.

From **individual** faculty prerogative to **collective** responsibility for student success.

From a culture of **isolation** to a culture of **collaboration**.

The evidence on student success in community colleges is distressing.

"Students don't do optional."

Almost a third (30%) of entering students do not attend orientation and most avoid online orientation;


about 90% indicate that academic planning and advising is important to them,

yet **less than a third** of entering students report that a college advisor helped them set academic goals and create a plan for achieving them;

and although a large majority of entering students are underprepared for college-level work, **76%** never use tutoring services.








MVCC Student Success Center - First Floor Plan








MVCC Student Success Center Second Floor Plan
