

## IVCC Profile and Quick Facts as of 10<sup>th</sup> Day 23/FA

IVCC was founded in 1924 as La Salle-Peru-Oglesby Junior College and was renamed Illinois Valley Community College in 1966. In 1968, IVCC moved to its current location in Oglesby, IL and the permanent campus, which encompasses 425 acres, was officially dedicated in 1972. The Ottawa Center was opened in 2010.

IVCC is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN), the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA), the Programs for the Emergency Medical Services Profession (CoAEMSP), and the National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF). IVCC is approved by the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB).
