

**SUBJECT:** Digital Textbook Discount Programs

Recently, I met with textbook publishers working to develop new models for purchasing digital textbooks and digital learning systems. These models are based on regulations issued by the U.S. Department of Education (34 CFR 668.164(c)(2)) which allow institutions of higher learning to charge students for books and supplies as part of tuition and fees. Coupled with the federal regulations, there are no provisions in state statute that would preclude Illinois community colleges from participating in digital discount programs.

I have included the attached information provided by the American Association of Publishers. If your college is interested in pursuing further, you may contact your textbook publisher.
