Admission to nursing is competitive and is based primarily on prerequisite GPA and secondarily on overall GPA and number of prerequisites completed. Contact NIU for details; once admitted, 5 semesters to complete. Application opens September (go.niu.edu/Nursing/ProgramApp) and all materials completed about 1 month prior to Jan.15th. Request transcripts be sent prior to leaving for winter break. NIU recommends transfer after one year. NIU will not accept a repeated course if the original grade was a "C" or higher, however you may repeat the course at NIU and the new grade will be utilized. Science lab classes must be completed within 7 years. All courses must be completed to start the program.
