Grade of “C” or better required in all “required courses”.	<p><b>Required courses available to be taken at IVCC:</b> ECE 1000, 1027, 2005; ECN1202, 2002 or 2003; EDC 2006; ENG 1001, 1002; GEG 1004; HIS 2000 or 2001; HPE 1008; LIT 2005; MTH 1003(req. for WIU MATH 260), 1008; PSI 1000; PSY 2001. 3 science courses (one must be a lab)-GEG1001 or 1005; 1 BIO; 1 GEL/CHM/PHY. 1 course from ART, MUS or THE.</p> <p>It is not possible to be admitted into WIU’s Early Childhood Education program directly from IVCC, because students must establish a WIU GPA and take C&amp;I110, MATH 260, SPED 250 and IDT 278 at WIU prior to formal admission to Teacher Education-Early Childhood Education. A student can choose to transfer after one year if seeking to graduate WIU after 4 total years of college. A student can choose to stay 2 years at IVCC in order to complete the vast majority of Pre-ECE requirements, but a minimum of 5 semesters will be spent at WIU after transfer. \*Students taking the ACT after 9-10-16 need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 6. If you took the ACT between 9-1-15 and 9-9-16 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 16. If you took the ACT before 9-1-15 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. combined English/Writing score of 19. Scores can be from separate ACT tests. \*Students taking the SAT after 3-5-16 need a min. composite score of 1110 (evidence-based reading and writing plus mathematics) and a minimum score of 26 on writing and language test. If you took SAT before 3-5-2016 need a min. 1030 composite score (critical reading + math) and a min. 450 in writing. Scores can be from separate SAT tests.
