| SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY | <u>College of Education and Human Services</u> B.S. leads to Teacher Licensure for grades 1-6 | 2.75 Passage of Illinois TAP test or ACT (with writing) score of 22 or higher required for admission. | To be eligible for admission to the Teacher Education Program, students must have 30 semester hours of completed college work with a 2.75 G.P.A. or higher. Grades of "C" or better are required in: EDC 2000, 2006; ENG 1001, 1002; HIS 2001; HPE 1003; LIT 2010 or 2011; MTH 1003, 1008, 1009, 1010; MUS 1000 or THE 2002; PSI 1000; SPH 1001. Additionally, SIUC has unique Science requirements for Education majors. Meeting the IAI science requirements for the AS degree will meet one of SIUC's two-course requirement. The other course must be taken at SIUC, but no additional time-to-degree should be incurred. It is not possible to be admitted into WIU's Elementary Education program directly from IVCC. If a student wishes to graduate in 4 years, it is advisable to transfer after one year at IVCC. A student can choose to stay 2 years at IVCC in order to complete as many requirements as possible, but a <i>minimum</i> of 5 semesters will be spent at WIU after transfer. *Students taking the **ACT** after 9-10-16 need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 6. If you took the **ACT** between 9-1-15 and 9-9-16 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 16. If you took the **ACT** before 9-1-15 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. combined English/Writing score of 19. Scores can be from separate ACT tests.
 *Students taking the **SAT** after 3-5-16 need a min. composite score of 1110 (evidence-based reading and writing plus mathematics) and a minimum score of 26 on writing and language test. If you took **SAT** before 3-5-2016 need a min. 1030 composite score (critical reading + math) and a min. 450 in writing. Scores can be from separate SAT tests.
