*Students taking the **ACT** after 9-10-16 need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 6. If you took the **ACT** between 9-1-15 and 9-9-16 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 16. If you took the **ACT** before 9-1-15 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. combined English/Writing score of 19. Scores can be from separate ACT tests.

*Students taking the **SAT** after 3-5-16 need a min. composite score of 1110 (evidence-based reading and writing plus mathematics) and a minimum score of 26 on writing and language test. If you took **SAT** before 3-5-2016 need a min. 1030 composite score (critical reading + math) and a min. 450 in writing. Scores can be from separate SAT tests.
