The exclusive sequencing of design courses at UIC precludes community college foundation courses such as ART from transferring-in. The design sequence at UIC is a 4-year sequence. It is advisable, therefore, that students spend no more than one year at the community college, and focus exclusively on completing the IAI general education core curriculum prior to transfer. Upon transfer, a student will still have 4 years at UIC to complete the design curriculum, and there is no guarantee that a student will be able to maintain full-time status during the last year of the program. <u>Graphic Design and Industrial Design:</u> Portfolios are not accepted. Select "Graphic/Industrial Foundation as your Major/Program of Study.
