Competitive Admission</p> <p>*listed courses weighted heavily in admission decision (A’s and B’s required) along w/ overall GPA</p> <p>RN/BSN 2.75 (all on-line + 1 practicum)</p>	<p>A “C” or better is required in the following: *ENG 1002, *BIO 1001 or 1003, *1007, *1008, *1009, *CHM 1004 or 1006, *MTH 1008, *PSY 1000, *ALH 1002 and *1000. Application can be made when 5 of the courses listed are completed (BIO 1007, 1008 count as 1 course). Also required is one of the following: ALH 1001, SOC 1000 or PHL 1002. <u>NIU has a specific formula for computing the admitting GPA which includes overall GPA and pre-nursing courses GPA and other factors.</u> Contact NIU for details. ACCUPLACER reading scores equivalent to the 12th grade (score of 79 or higher) will be required of <u>all</u> students unless already RN, or have an ACT reading sub score of 24 or higher. See Sarah Trager in the IVCC Assessment Center to send scores to NIU’s testing department. Once admitted, 5 semesters to complete. Application and all materials completed about 1 month prior to Jan. 15th. Request tran be sent prior to leaving for winter break. NIU recommends transfer after one year. NIU will not accept a repeated course if the original grade was a “C” or higher, however you may repeat the course at NIU and the new grade will be utilized. Science lab classes must be completed within 7 years. <u>RN/BSN</u> All courses above except BIO1001, students should follow the NIU Plus for quicker transfer otherwise complete IAI. SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY - Carbondale	<p>B.S.N. – Traditional option offered by SIUE (but on the Carbondale campus)</p>	<p>2.5 minimum cum. GPA</p> <p>2.7 in pre-requisite courses</p>	<p>This is a Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville program, but is offered as an extension program at SIU-Carbondale’s campus. It is a Fall-start program. Transfer after one year is recommended, as the program is designed as a 1 + 3 year program. If a student wishes to stay at IVCC to complete an AS degree, all but one general education course will be met at SIUC (“Interdisciplinary Studies”), and the sequence Nursing courses will take 3 years to complete. In order to gain admission after one year, the following IVCC courses should be taken: BIO 1007, 1008, 1009; CHM 1004, 1005; ENG 1001, 1002; PSY 1000; SPH 1001.</p> <p>If transferring after 2 years, then an AS degree is recommended, and should include MTH 1008, PHL 1002, ALH 1000, 1001, 1002. http://science.siu.edu/advisement/health_advisement/information/nursing.html3/18</p>

AS degree</p> <p>Recommended supportive coursework: ALH 1000, ALH 1002; ENG 1001, 1002; PSY 1000, 2001; SOC 1000. Additionally, 3 semester hours from Understanding the Past, 3 semester hours from Understanding the Creative Arts, and 3 credit hours from Exploring World Cultures from UIC’s General Education distribution areas is recommended prior to transfer.
