The program will take a minimum of 3 years once on SIUC's campus. Recommended courses: MTH 1005; PHY 2003, 2004. UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS CHICAGO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> B.A. Architectural Studies 	2.75 for fullest consideration for admitted transfer students. Mid-Range 2.8-3.7	Recommended transfer courses: ART 1000, 1010; ENG 1001, 1002; MTH 2001; PHY 2003. Please note: It is to the student's advantage to attend UIC as soon as possible. The architecture sequence of courses is 4 years in duration (beginning Fall 2013). No portfolio is required for admission unless a student is seeking "advanced standing", and IVCC does not have the design software to qualify. The best-case scenario for transfer students is to complete the IAI including the general education course listed above in 1 year, then transfer. Upon transfer, students would still have 4 years to complete the program. Full-time status at UIC cannot be guaranteed for the entire 4 years.
