IVCC Transfer Guide for Pre-Physical Therapy Majors

Students wishing to transfer for Pre-Physical Therapy can choose any major but need to complete the Pre-Physical Therapy courses prescribed by each university. All state universities (NIU, ISU, SIU-C, SIU-E, WIU, EIU, and U of I) offer a Pre-Physical Therapy curriculum. Colleges listed below offer the Physical Therapy degree. Please see a counselor when choosing your classes.

Eight courses must be completed at time of application (BIO1007, 1008 are 1 course). Limited retention, must maintain a 3.0 to remain. It is recommended that Math and Science sequences are completed before transfer. Twelve hours of a concentration area above and beyond required course work (activity courses don't apply) required. Once all are completed you may apply. Two letters of recommendation, 50 hours experience in 2 diff settings (inpatient & outpatient) and a separate application are required. Excellent interview skills are essential. All attempts of repeat courses are used in calculating required GPA. NIU recommends transfers after 1 year, if not, apply at least 1 month prior to February 15 of 2 nd year. Ask your counselor about IAI. Mark Health Sciences on application for major. Thirty-six accepted per year.
