Must be admitted to the subject area, and apply to Secondary Education Minor. It can be very difficult for junior-level transfers to complete the program in 2 years after transfer, therefore a sophomore-level transfer, if possible, should be considered. Additionally, C's or better are required in all other major and directed general education courses. See specific discipline for requirements.  Completion of 30 credit hours and an established WIU GPA is required for formal admission to all teacher education programs. It is therefore advisable for IVCC students to take the above courses and additional general education coursework in their first year, and then transfer to WIU.  Pass the TAP, SAT or ACT* required for admission.  #Students must take one Global Issues course <u>or</u> Foreign Lang of 3yrs in HS <u>or</u> 3 coll. sem <u>and</u> one Multicultural Studies course. Courses may double dip Gen Ed/Global or Multi/Global but <u>NOT</u> Gen Ed/Multi, some majors at WIU incorporate the Global Issues course in the lower/ upper level curriculum. \*Students taking the ACT after 9-10-16 need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 6. If you took the ACT between 9-1-15 and 9-9-16 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 16. If you took the ACT before 9-1-15 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. combined English/Writing score of 19. Scores can be from separate ACT tests.  
\*Students taking the SAT after 3-5-16 need a min. composite score of 1110 (evidence-based reading and writing plus mathematics) and a minimum score of 26 on writing and language test. If you took SAT before 3-5-2016 need a min. 1030 composite score (critical reading + math) and a min. 450 in writing. Scores can be from separate SAT tests. 4/18
