GPA Passage of Illinois TAP or an ACT (with writing) score of 22 or higher	Required for Admission: EDC 1000, 2000 (or PSY 2001); ENG 1001, 1002; MTH 1009; PSY 1000; 2 courses in Life/Physical Sciences; 30 or more transfer credit hours is required for transfer admission to Special Ed. Recommended prior to transfer: MTH 1009, 1010; Cultural Studies (both Western, and Non-Western), Humanities & Arts; Language graduation requirement of 3 years high school or through 3 rd semester college. A minimum of 6 semesters will be required on UIUC's campus to complete this program, so transfer after one year should be considered. As part of the admission process to Special Education, verification of a minimum of 50 clock hours of experience with students with disabilities is required. *Students taking the ACT after 9-10-16 need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 6. If you took the ACT between 9-1-15 and 9-9-16 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. writing score of 16. If you took the ACT before 9-1-15 you need a min. composite score of 22 and a min. combined English/Writing score of 19. Scores can be from separate ACT tests.

*Students taking the SAT after 3-5-16 need a min. composite score of 1110 (evidence-based reading and writing plus mathematics) and a minimum score of 26 on writing and language test. If you took SAT before 3-5-2016 need a min. 1030 composite score (critical reading + math) and a min. 450 in writing. Scores can be from separate SAT tests.
