## AFTER THE GED® TEST

Once a GED tester has passed the **GED**® **test** and the **Constitution Test\*** as required by Illinois Compiled Statutes - School Code (105 ILCS 5/27-3), the tester should contact or visit the local Regional Office of Education (ROE)\* of which the tester currently resides with a government issued photo ID to request an Illinois High School Equivalency Certificate and Official Transcript. (The fee in the form of cash or money order is \$10 each to obtain an official transcript and/or a certificate.)
