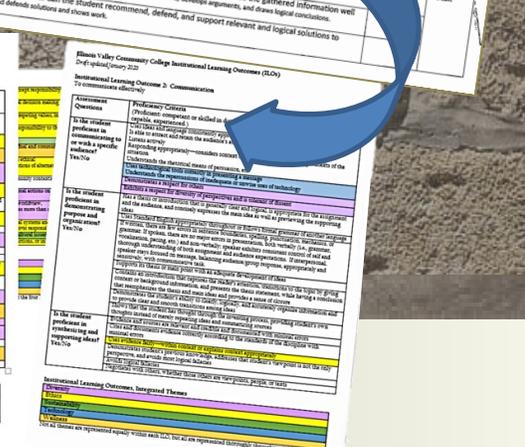
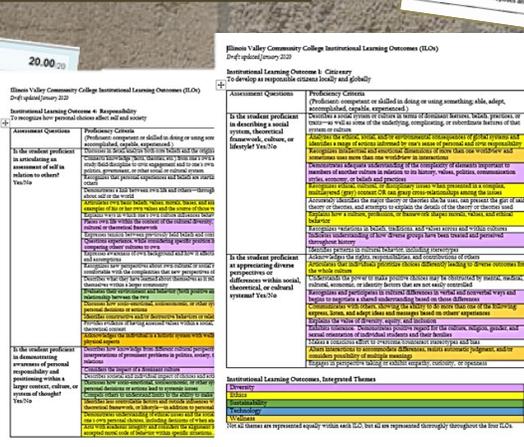
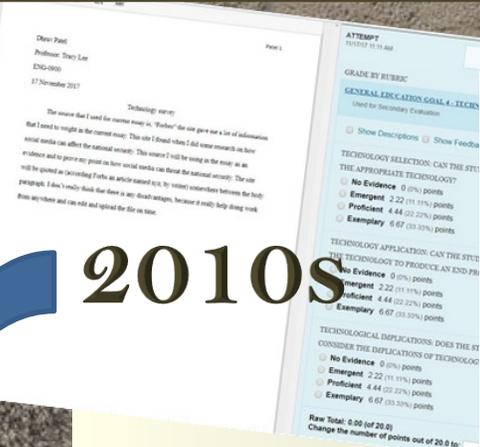
# What a great moment to remember how we have arrived where we are and appreciate all that we have built to ensure that our future students and IVCC continue to be successful.



**1990s:** We all assessed using our own metrics, resulting in data that could not be combined to answer institutional questions.

**2000s:** We created institutional assessment tools to assess our 8 Ged Ed goals, but our methods were very labor-intensive and prone to human error.

**2010s:** We transitioned to assessing inside Blackboard, which was complicated and time-consuming.



Now, assessment occurs with grading inside Brightspace and only requires a few clicks—and the data goes directly into a dashboard, accessible to the Assessment Committee co-chairs.

# Instructions for How to Assess in Brightspace

(You can create an Assignment column for this and hide it from students and not attach it to the gradebook, if you wish.)

## How do you do this?

Once you've logged into Brightspace,

1. Click on the **Discover** link in the center of the top-center navigation bar.
2. In the Discover/Search... box, search for **Institutional Learning Goals, Outcomes, and Evidence**
3. Click **Enroll in Course**. You will then be enrolled in the course and see it in your course list.
4. Please work through the course; it should take less than an hour for most people and teach you what you need to know about assessing Learning Outcomes in **Brightspace** courses.
