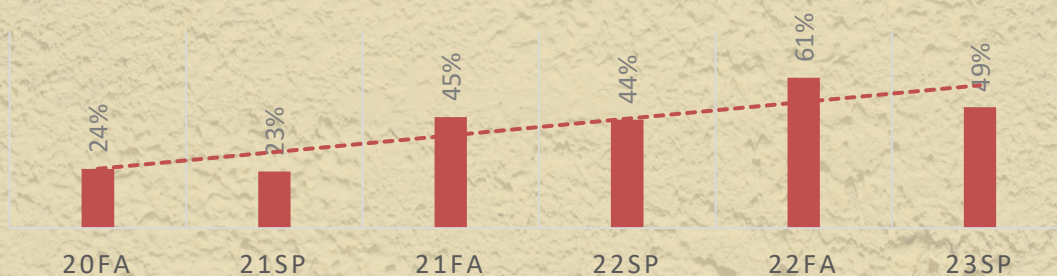

As many of you know, IVCC was referred for monitoring to the HLC because of our previous lack of progress in implementing assessment measures in the past. We have just submitted our Interim Report for Core Component 4.B: Assessment of Student Learning, and we are hopeful that we have improved enough to be taken off that monitoring.

How did we do? We mostly made improvements, until this past Spring. We would be more confident if more people had participated in the Spring, as providing assessment data is an expectation that the HLC has of all faculty.

Don't know how? We have a Brightspace training class for that!

Once you've logged into Brightspace,

1. Click on the **Discover** link in the center of the top-center navigation bar.
2. In the Discover/Search... box, search for **Institutional Learning Goals, Outcomes, and Evidence**
3. Click **Enroll in Course**. You then will be enrolled in the course and see it in your course list.
4. Please work through the course; it should take less than an hour for most people and teach you what you need to know about assessing Learning Outcomes in Brightspace courses.
5. If you have any questions or want expert help, please contact CETLA or the Assessment Committee—and remember each division has a member!

The Assessment Committee is looking at transferring the Assessment Plans that we have received into a more useful format than sets of web form data boxes and may contact you soon with questions for clarifying your plan or plans.
