






DANVILLE, Ill. (WCIA) — After winning a \$95,000 grant, the Danville Area Community College is getting an upgrade to its environmental energy education by adding geothermal energy training programs.

DACC received the grant from the Illinois Green Economy Network in late September. They now plan to buy equipment to train students in how to repair geothermal units. The units, which can be found in the Danville Campus Tech Center, are highly energy-efficient and use underground water
