### ITEMS

- ❖ **Fingerprinting Criminal Background Check should be done prior to the start of the class.** (fee paid for by the student at the time of fingerprinting) If these are not done and the results received prior to clinical you will be dismissed from the CNA program.
- ❖ **Bring the fingerprinting receipt and give it to your instructor at your first face to face meeting.**
- ❖ **If you have a disqualifying conviction(s), you must obtain a waiver before starting this course.**
- ❖ **Physical Exam, 2 step TB testing and 10 panel drug screens are due on, or before TBA (fees for these are paid for by the student). If these are not done and the results received before clinical starts, you will be dismissed from the CNA program.**
- ❖ **If you are pregnant you must bring a release from your obstetrician on your first day of class. If you have any restrictions, you will not be able participate in the CNA program at this time.**
- ❖ **Competency Exam \$75.00 (Prepaid in college course fees). To be eligible to take the state competency exam you must successfully complete the course by passing both in theory with a “C” (75%) or better and have “Passed” the clinical portion of the program. The dates of the state competency exam will vary depending on program completion date the information is noted on the last day of Lecture Assignment guide.**
  
- ✓ Name Tag - available at the Records office. Oglesby campus during regular business hours
- ✓ **Scrubs: SCRUB TOP MUST BE A WHITE SCRUB PANTS MUST BE NAVY BLUE and will be worn to clinical only. Please Note: Scrubs must fit properly not to tight when sitting, stooping, or bending. Undergarments must not be visible when sitting, stooping, or bending. The pants cannot drag on the ground.**
- ✓ Gym shoes with non-slip soles (Any color, must be clean). No Crocs, clogs, backless, or open toe
- ✓ Socks
- ✓ Wristwatch with second hand. (No smart watches)
- ✓ Black ballpoint pen for clinical notes
- ✓ Small pocket size notebook (optional)
- ✓ Make copies of the physical and TB for your records **10 panel Drug Screen:** The drug screen results will be sent directly to the NA program coordinator at IVCC.
