You will be responsible for pages 470 - 480 and 490 - 491 from the text's chapter on Social Psychology. Make sure that you can answer the following questions to be prepared for the fourth test.

Who was Kitty Genovese? What happened to her? How did Social Psychologists explain this tragic story?

What is an *attribution*? What types of *attributions* have emerged from the research? Which do we frequently employ to explain other people's behavior? How about our own? Which type do we typically use in the United States?

What was discovered in the (in)famous Milgram experiment? What was the primary determinant of the participant's behavior? Was it their personality, morals, or upbringing: or was it something else? What factors lead participants to not obey the experiment's requirements?

What happened at Stanford in the course of Zimbardo's "Prison Study"? Why did some of the guards behave in that manner?

What did Solomon Asch uncover regarding our tendency to "go along with the crowd"? When do people not comply with the majority?

What is *Groupthink*? Why is it a bad thing? How does it arise? What's an example? How do we prevent it?
