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B. Income to be Verified

STUDENTS – Choose One:

PARENT(S) – Choose One:

- My parent(s) filed a 2020 IRS income tax return. They used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool in the FAFSA *or* attached a 2020 IRS Tax Return Transcript/signed copy of their 2020 Tax Return.
- My parent filed an amended IRS income tax return in 2020. A signed copy of the original 1040 return and the 1040X amended return are attached.

Using the “IRS Link” in FAFSA on the Web (visit www.ivcc.edu/faforms for more detailed instructions):

Go to Studentaid.gov, log in to the student’s FAFSA, select “Make FAFSA Corrections,” and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. From there, follow the instructions to determine if the student is eligible to use the IRS Link to transfer 2020 IRS income tax information into the student’s FAFSA.

Ordering an “IRS Tax Return Transcript” (visit www.ivcc.edu/faforms for more detailed instructions):

To obtain an IRS tax return transcript, go to www.IRS.gov. Click on “Get my Tax Record on the homepage. You will have a choice to get the transcript online or order by mail. If you order by mail, you may expect to receive the transcript in 1-2 weeks to the address listed on your tax return. You can also call 1-800-908-9946. Make sure to request the “IRS Tax Return Transcript.”

Ordering an “IRS Verification of Non-filing” (visit www.ivcc.edu/faforms for more detailed instructions):

Use the enclosed 4506-T form or go to IRS.gov, hover over “Forms & Instructions” then click on 4506-T. You will need to check box #7 and enter in Tax period – 12/31/20.
