

2022-2023 Victims of IRS Identity Theft

Victims of identity theft who cannot get a return transcript from www.irs.gov, or who are unable to use the IRS Link from www.studentaid.gov, must submit a Tax Return Database View (TRDBV) transcript. They also must submit a statement they have signed and dated indicating that they have been victims of tax-related identity theft, and that the IRS has been made aware of it.

To request a TRDBV, contact the IRS's Identity Protection Specialized Unit (IPSU) at 800-908-4490. After the IPSU authenticates the tax filer's identity, ask the IRS to mail the TRDBV transcript to you.
