There are 15 high schools completely in IVCC's district: DePue, Earlville, Hall, La Moille, La Salle-Peru, Marquette Academy, Mendota, Ottawa, Princeton, Putnam County, Serena, St. Bede Academy, Streator, Woodland, and La Salle-Peru Christian, and 5 schools that are partially in IVCC's district: Bureau Valley, Fieldcrest, Henry-Senachwine, Midland, and, Seneca.
