

## Illinois Valley Community College Professional Truck Driver Training Certificates

### Basic Certificate

TDT 1201 - 3 HRS. Credit Classroom  
TDT 1202 - 7 HRS. Credit Equipment

Truck Driver Training students receive 160 hours of driver training. The program uses 10 speed manual transmission and 53-foot dry box van trailers. 1 instructor to 3 students during outside equipment training.

### Day classes

- 4 weeks long.
- Monday through Friday  
8:00AM - 4:30 PM.
  - Night Classes
- 6 weeks long.
- Monday through Friday from  
5:00 PM -10:00 PM

Gain valuable experience in:

- Shifting manual 10 speed
- Log book skills
- Backing skills
- Turning with 53ft trailer

The program is appropriate for entry level commercial truck drivers and meets all Federal Motor Carrier Laws. Refresher Program is available to students that need to renew Class A CDL and have experience and hold a valid permit.

Classes are taught by professionals who have years of classroom teaching experience as well as over-the-road driving experience.

The program utilizes equipment that meets today's standards: 2017 Volvos with 10 speed transmissions and 53 foot dry box

## IVCC Truck Driver Training Also Offers

### Refresher Programs

#### TDT 2275 Truck Driver Permit Testing

This course is the 40 hour classroom presentation of the truck driver training program and is designed for people that need to renew their existing commercial driver's license. This course will provide the student with a basic orientation on commercial driver's license requirements, and will concentrate on the rules, regulations and other requirements necessary to prepare students for the written portion of the CDL examination.

#### TDT 2210 Equipment Refresher Training

This course includes 40 hours of hands-on, over-the-road driving of equipment and review of class A commercial driver's license requirements. Student must have a current DOT physical, drug screen and a Class A CDL license. A driving test is required to qualify for refresher program.
