- Household income must be under 200% of the poverty income guidelines.
- Must be planning to attend an accredited Illinois postsecondary educational institution during the fall of 2024.
- Must reside in Bureau, Carroll, LaSalle, Lee, Marshall,
 Ogle, Putnam, Stark, or Whiteside counties.
