Early Childhood Education (Preschool/Primary teacher licensure program) 	2.0 for non-teacher program 2.75 for teacher licensure program	To be eligible for admission to the Teacher Education Program, students must have 30 semester hours of completed college work with a 2.75 G.P.A. or higher. Grades of “C” or better are required in: ECE 1201, 1203; EDC 2000, 2006; ENG 1001, 1002; HIS 2001; MTH 1003, 1009, 1010; MUS 1000 or THE 2002; PSI 1000; SPH 1001. Additionally, SIUC has unique Science requirements for Education majors. Meeting the IAI science requirements for the AS degree will meet one of SIUC’s two-course requirement. The other course must be taken at SIUC, but no additional time-to-degree should be incurred. Other courses recommended prior to transfer (to meet Illinois State Board of Education ECE requirements): ECE 1000; EDC 2000 (PSY 1000 is pre-requisite). Choose one from: ECN 1202 or 2002, or 2003. Choose one from: GEG 1003 or 1004. Choose one from: HIS 2000 or 2001. Choose one from: PSI 1000 or 1002 or 2000. BS in Ed Studies requires a minor and has same requirements as above, but in lieu of student teaching will have an internship experience. It is not possible to be admitted into WIU’s Early Childhood Education program directly from IVCC, because students must establish a WIU GPA and take C&I110, ECH271, MATH 260, SPED 250 and IDT 278 at WIU prior to formal admission to Teacher Education-Early Childhood Education. A student can choose to transfer after one year if seeking to graduate WIU after 4 total years of college.
