TIME IS MONEY, AND NLU WILL SAVE STUDENTS BOTH.

This Direct to Success (D2S) scholarship makes us among the most affordable private universities for transfer students. To be eligible for the D2S Scholarship, students must meet all graduation requirements for the associate's degree at your college, achieved a 2.0 GPA, and successfully transfer to National Louis University within one year of graduation from the college. To achieve full benefit of the scholarship, part-time students must complete program within three years.

TUITION

The D2S Scholarship covers **25% of the NLU tuition***, with adjusted rates as follow:

PER QUARTER HOUR	\$323
PER TERM	\$4,845 (BASED ON 15 QH)
PER ACADEMIC YEAR	\$14,535 (BASED ON 45 QH)
