IVCC doesn’t offer a course equivalent to NIU’s CHM 310 so either transfer after 1.5 yrs or take IVCC’s CHM2002(CHM1007 is the pre-req), BUT if pursuing further education to become a Registered Dietician (RDN), CHM310/311 will be required at NIU.
