



PLACEMENT INTERPRETATION GUIDE

Placement Scores (ACCUPLACER) are valid for 2 years from date of testing

ACT scores are valid for 2 years from date of testing

PARCC scores are valid for 5 years from date of testing

SAT scores (current version) are valid for 2 years from date of testing

High School Equivalency (HiSET) Results are valid for 2 years from date of testing

For those who took the SAT before March 2016 (old version of SAT) and wish to have scores considered for placement, please contact the Dean of English, Math and Education at (815) 224-0433.

Please note in the SAT subject area, the tests for Reading/English are combined and referred to as Evidence Based Reading and Writing.
