



PLACEMENT INTERPRETATION GUIDE

Effective 10/2018

Placement Scores (ACCUPLACER) are valid for 2 years from date of testing

ENGLISH ACT scores are valid for 2 years from date of testing

PARCC scores are valid for 5 years from date of testing

SAT scores (current version) are valid for 2 years from date of testing

High School Equivalency (HiSET) Results are valid for 2 years from date of testing

Please note in the SAT subject area, the tests for Reading/English are combined and referred to as Evidence Based Reading and Writing. This SAT scores allows students

An ACT English score of 19 also makes a student eligible for ENG 1001 or 1205. An ACT Reading score has no impact on making a student eligible directly for ENG 1001 or 1205. An ACT Reading score of 21 or higher would exempt a student from the Reading placement test, but would need for the student to take an Accuplacer English test.

MATH PLACEMENT

Arithmetic exam in Accuplacer is still the title of the entry level math test in either Classic or Next Gen version of Accuplacer testing. Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra and Statistics (QRS) has replaced the Elementary Algebra exam. The College Level Math exam is now titled Advanced Algebra and Functions (AAF) in the Next Gen version of Accuplacer.
