

Citing Gale resources using MLA 7th edition

The MLA “Works Cited” page is double-spaced with hanging indents. Resources are listed in alphabetical order.

For ebooks versions, the “Access date” should be formatted as follows:
Date Month Year Example: 15 Sept. 2009

Note: In the citation on page 2 you will notice the N.p. abbreviation. This is used when no place is listed for the publisher of the book.

If the work originally appeared in a periodical AND you are using a Gale book (not the ebook):

Author(Last name, First name). “Title of article.” *Periodical title* Volume.Issue (Date): Page numbers. Rpt. in *Title of Gale Resource*. Ed. Name. Vol. Number. Detroit: Gale, Year. Page numbers. Medium.

Gosse, Edmund. “Ibsen’s Social Dramas.” *Fortnightly Review* 45.265 (1989): 107-21. Rpt. in *Drama for Students*. Ed. David Galens and Lynn Spampinato. Vol. 1. Detroit: Gale, 1998. 120-21. Print.

If the work originally appeared in a periodical AND you are using a Gale ebook:

Author(Last name, First name). “Title of article.” *Periodical title* Volume.Issue (Date): Page numbers. Rpt. in *Title of Gale Resource*. Ed. Name. Vol. Number. Detroit: Gale, Year. Page numbers. Subscription Service. Medium. Access date.

If the work originally appeared in a book AND you are using a Gale book (not the ebook):

Author(Last name, First name). "Chapter title." *Book title*. Ed. Name. City: Publisher, Year. Page numbers. Rpt. in *Title of Gale Resource*. Ed. Name. Vol. Number. Detroit: Gale, Year. Page numbers. Medium.

If the work originally appeared in a book AND you are using a Gale ebook:

Author(Last name, First name). "Chapter title." *Book title*. Ed. Name. City: Publisher, Year. Page numbers. Rpt. in *Title of Gale Resource*. Ed. Name. Vol. Number. Detroit: Gale, Year. Page numbers. Subscription Service. Medium. Access date.

Wagner-Martin, Linda. "Gilman's 'The Yellow Wallpaper': A Centenary." *Charlotte Perkins Gilman, The Woman and Her Work*. Ed. Sheryl L. Meyering. N.p.: UMI, 1989. 51-64. Rpt. in *Short Stories for Students*. Ed. Kathleen Wilson. Vol. 1. Detroit: Gale, 1997. 290-92. *Gale Virtual Reference Library*. Web. 15 Sept. 2009.

There are several entries in the Gale Series that were specially written for the series. These are generally the material that appears under the headings "Introduction", "Biographical Information", "Criticism Reception" etc.

If you are using the Gale book (not the ebook):

"Title of Entry". *Book Title*. Ed. Name. Vol. Number. Detroit: Gale, Year. Page numbers. Medium.

"A Jury of Her Peers." *Short Stories for Students*. Ed. Kathleen Wilson. Vol. 3. Detroit: Gale, 1998. 155-56. Print.

If you are using the Gale ebook version:

"Title of Entry". *Book Title*. Ed. Name. Vol. Number. Detroit: Gale, Year. Page numbers. Subscription Service. Medium. Access date.

“A Jury of Her Peers.” *Short Stories for Students*. Ed. Kathleen Wilson. Vol. 3. Detroit: Gale, 1998. 155-56. *Gale Virtual Reference Library*. Web. 14 Sept. 2009.

A few essays are specially commissioned by Gale.

If you are using the Gale book (not the ebook):

Author(Last name, First name). Essay on "Title of Work". *Title of Book*. Ed. Name. Vol. Number.
Detroit: Gale, Year. Page numbers. Medium.

Metzger, Sheri. Essay on "A Doll's House". *Drama for Students*. Ed. David Galens and Lynn Spampinato. Vol. 1. Detroit: Gale, 1998. 116-19. Print.

If you are using the Gale ebook version:

Author(Last name, First name). Essay on "Title of Work". *Title of Book*. Ed. Name. Vol. Number.
Detroit: Gale, Year. Page numbers. Subscription Service. Medium. Access date.

Metzger, Sheri. Essay on "A Doll's House." *Drama for Students*. Ed. David Galens and Lynn Spampinato. Vol. 1. Detroit: Gale, 1998. 116-19. *Gale Virtual Reference Library*. Web. 15 Sept. 2009.

Remember: Your instructor is the final authority on citing sources!
